### **Product Introduction**

This is a vinyl record player with two independent speakers, with superior sound quality, it can support 7-inch, 10-inch, 12-inch records and 33RPM, 45RPM and 78 RPM three speed, it has three modes of Bluetooth, LP and USB playback, and mode switch comes with a beep and light indication.

#### **Before Use**


- When choosing a location for the unit, avoid placing it in direct sunlight or close to a source of heat. Also avoid locations subject to vibrations and excessive dust, cold or moisture. Keep away from sources that hum, such as transformers or motors.
- 2. Do not open the cabinet as this may result in damage to the circuitry or electrical shock
- 3. Be sure not to handle record with dirty fingers. Never play a record that has a crack on the surface.
- 4. When removing the power plug from the wall outlet, always pull directly on the plug, never pull the cord.
- 5. To protect the stylus, don't forget to put on the white protective needle cover after use.
- 6. Do not attempt to clean the unit with chemical solvents as this might damage the finish. Use a clean, dry cloth.
- 7. In order to shut off the power to this product completely, unplug the power cord from the wall outlet. Be sure to unplug the unit if you do not intend to use it for an extended period of time, such as a vacation.
- 8. Keep this manual in a safe place for future refere.





# **Function Descriptions**

# 1. Connecting the External Speakers


 Use the red cable of the speaker to connect to "R", and connect the white cable to "I"



# 2. Using the LP Playback Mode

**Note:** Please release the lock before moving the tonearm and remove the stylus protector.

**LP Playback Mode:** When lifting up and moving the tonearm (§) to the player, the player will automatically switch to the **LP Playback** mode with the prompt tone "Di-dong" and the indicator light showing green, which indicates that it has successfully entered the **LP Playback** mode.



**Note:** When the product is turned off with the auto-stop swich, the turntable player will continue spinning, no matter whether playing a record or not.

**Do not** lower the tonearm manually onto the LP player in order to avoid damage to the player or the stylus **(10)**.

### Steps of playing a record:

- 1. Place the record of your choice on the turntable. If required, do not forget to place the adaptor on the record spindle.
- 2. Choose the desired playing speed using the speed selection switch between 33.3, 45 and 78rpm.
- 3. Turn on the Rotary Power Switch, note that this also controls volume.
- 4. Release the tone arm lock. Place the stylus vertically over the first track of the record, the turntable will start turning automatically.
- 5. The record could be controlled by auto-stop ON/OFF switch when it comes to the end.
- 6. Lift up the tone arm and put it on the rest when finished. Replace the protective cap on the stylus and close the tone arm lock.
- 7. Turn off power at mains.

### 3. Using the Bluetooth Mode

#### **Bluetooth Mode:**

- When the tonearm is in the arm holder, you can activate the **Bluetooth** mode.
   When the product is in the **Bluetooth** mode, the blue indicator light flashes quickly, which means it is now ready to pair.
- Please find the Bluetooth name "Vintage Turntable" on your Bluetooth-enabled device to connect it with your product. As Bluetooth pairs successfully, the blue indicator light remains on with the prompt tone: "Di-dong".

### 4. Using the Headphone Mode

For private listening, connect the 3.5mm plug from the Earphone/Headphone(not suppied) into the **Headphone jack** on the side of unit. Sound from speakers will be auto cut.

### 5. Using the USB Flash

- Insert the USB flash to the port (B), the player will automatically play the digital audio stored in the USB flash.
- Press the hibutton to play/pause as needed, and press the hibutton to play the previous or next song.

#### **Care and Maintenance**

# 1. How to replace the stylus

- 1. Push the arm lock to release the tonearm.
- 2. Take off cartridge cap to expose needle.
- 3. Lightly separate cartridge from the socket.
- 4. Take out audio-line from cartridge completely.
- 5. Fit new stylus reverse process, insert audio cable and install cartridge into socket. NOTE: The jeweled stylus installed in your turntable should last for up to 300 hours of playback with 33 RPM albums or 45 RPM. If you are playing older 78 RPM records, which are made from a much harder material, the life expectancy of the stylus will be reduced.

### 2. How to clean the system

- 1. Use a soft dry cloth to wipe dust.
- 2. Keep the lid closed to protect the turntable components from dust.
- 3. A record cleaning brush can be used to remove dirt from the record's grooved surface.
- 4. If there is visible foreign matter on the tip of the stylus, please remove it carefully with a soft stylus-cleaning brush.

# **Trouble Shooting**

#### When the playback sound becomes distorted and unsatisfactory:

- 1. Please confirm that no dust or lint has accumulated on the stylus tip.
- 2. If there is visible foreign matter on the tip of the stylus, please remove it with a soft stylus-cleaning brush. If there is no visible foreign matter on the stylus and the sound is still unsatisfactory, it is likely that the stylus is worn and needs to be replaced.

#### When the turntable is not spinning:

- 1. Check whether the belt is loose, if loose, just re-set on or replace the belt.
- 2. Check whether the motor is working, if the motor stops working, please contact VANGOA customer service **CS@vangoa.com**, we will give you a solution.
